

GKHAT is a volunteer driven organization; parent volunteers fuel all aspects of GKHAT and play a major role in the success of our programs. The club relies on generous volunteer contributions to keep the club running smoothly.

We are a welcoming team, and have a place for anyone who is interested in participating. No experience with ski racing or previous board membership is necessary. This is a great way to help support and shape the quality of your child's ski experience.

2025-26 Registration - 2-day pricing!

What you need to know:

- Registration will open <u>June 19</u> and close on <u>July 19</u>.
 - U6 minis capped at 12 Saturday & 12 Sunday.
 - Ski Academy guaranteed spots for 9, will consider more if we GKHAT can make it work.
 - Kimberly race fees included in U10 registration fees. Last season there were 52
 GKHATer at this race and we hope for another large contingent this season.

GKHAT will continue to offer 2-day programming (U8-U16) with the huge <u>discount of 50%</u> on the second day. Last season we had <u>21 multi-day athletes</u> as young as U8 and all the way up to U16. The benefits to training 2-days a week are many! Some include:

- SIGNIFICANT improvement: when your athlete trains 2 days a week on snow, the development we have seen in the past is massive.
- Different coaches and new friends: your athlete will likely have an entirely different team and coach on the two different days.

- Practice at different disciplines: your athlete will get broader training of Giant Slalom, Slalom and Ski Cross when training twice a week. Head Coach Ryan often sets one discipline on Saturday and the other on Sunday. By training both days, your athlete will be guaranteed to improve at both!
- You can miss a day or two: other sports, ski races, birthday parties, illness, holidays.
 These are all conflicts that can pop up during the short winter season. GKHAT has
 consciously reduced the price of the second day because we know that your athlete
 likely will miss a day or two. No one likes to waste \$.
- Its very economical. You can register any combination of Friday/Saturday/Sunday ages U8 through to U16.

2025-26 Ski Academy

The GKHAT Ski Academy Program is for grade 8 and 9 students who want to learn what it takes to train at a competitive level, and build the skills needed to be a high level skier in any discipline. This program runs from September to May, one afternoon a week, starting with dryland training in the fall and transitioning onto snow with some pre-season sessions at Lake Louise until Kicking Horse opens.

Registration will be open for this program on June 19th and we expect it to fill up. There will be guaranteed 9 spots so don't delay in registering. GKHAT might be able to accommodate more, but subject to a review by Ryan and the board. This year's program fee will be \$1475 plus BC Alpine fees.
